Fall 2018 PDE3 Workshops For Educators

Participants will engage in hands-on STEM activities designed to involve students of all ages in the prevention of rat lungworm disease through project-based learning. Workshop content is based on the new Rat Lungworm Disease Curriculum Manual developed by the University of Hawai'i at Hilo College of Pharmacy.

- Explore the rat lungworm life cycle and Integrated Pest Management (IPM) for control of slugs and snails.
- Use design thinking to build slug traps for school and home gardens.
- Learn how to set up a story map in ArcGIS.
- Receive your own printed copy of the Rat Lungworm Disease Curriculum Manual.
