



# Coconut Rhinoceros Beetle Compliance Checklist

## Nurseries

*Wholesale and retail nurseries, tree farms, garden stores*

- Attend a CRB compliance training
- Inspect plants 48 hours before transport
- Have CRB ID cards available for staff
- Keep propagation material in a sealed container
- Remove any stockpiled greenwaste

## Generators:

*Landscapers, tree trimmers, arborists, County/State Depts, Resorts, etc.*

- Attend a CRB compliance training
- Check mulch piles. Cover or place in sealed container
- Remove any stockpiled greenwaste
- Have CRB ID cards available for staff

## Haulers:

*Truckers, roll-offs, waste removal*

- Attend a CRB compliance training
- Remove any stockpiled greenwaste
- Properly clean vehicles after transporting CRB host material
- Have CRB ID cards available for staff

## Processors:

*West Hawai'i Organics Facility*

- Attend a CRB compliance training
- Promote CRB training to haulers without a valid compliance agreement
- Chip, grind, or heat treat CRB host material within 72 hours
- Ensure piles reach a core temp of 131°F

**Report any suspect larva, beetles, breeding sites, or damage**
